Dear Parent / Carer

Re: Year 10 (current year 9) Ski trip 2nd-9th April 2022

We are very pleased to be able to offer your child the opportunity to participate in the Year 10 ski trip to Bormio, Italy in April 2022. This trip is open to all students currently in Year 9.

The cost of the trip is **£1,175**. This will cover return flights from Manchester Airport, full board accommodation at Hotel Sant Anton, lift passes, ski school, equipment hire and insurance. During our stay, the students will participate in ski school for at least 4 hours every day with a qualified ski instructor.

Pupils will need to bring their own passport for the trip, these will be collected and held in school prior to the trip. Passports will need to be less than 10 years old and you will need to have 6 months left on them on the day of travel. Insurance for the trip will be arranged.

If you wish your child to take part, please consent and pay the deposit of £250 via Parent Pay by Monday 28th June. **This is non-refundable**. All payments should be made via our online payment service, ParentPay and we are unable to accept cash or cheque payments.

The well-being and consideration of all pupils wishing to take part is paramount. Any pupil whose behaviour gives cause for concern may have their place withdrawn at any time with the possibility of losing any money already paid if a replacement pupil cannot be found or deposits have been paid to the company

In order to spread the cost, it is suggested that payments are paid regularly. Due to commitments regarding invoices from the tour operator the following deadlines will apply and all payments are non-refundable:

- Payment 1
 £250 (deposit) by 28th June 2021

 Payment 2
 £300 by 6th September 2021

 Payment 3
 £200 by 8th November 2021
- Payment 4 £300 by 24th January 2022
- Payment 5 £125 by 7th March 2022

Failure to comply with this could result in your child's place being lost. The total contribution of **£1,175** must be made in full by Monday 7th March 2022. Should the trip not go ahead due to COVID all monies will be refunded in full.
