At times, this has been challenging with national lockdowns, tiered local restrictions, changing guidance for educational providers, self-isolation periods and remote education. On Friday, our Year 7 and 8 children visited Chester Zoo. From speaking to the children when they returned to school on Friday afternoon, they certainly thoroughly enjoyed the whole experience and really valued the opportunity to make memories with their peers taking in all that the Zoo has to offer. Our trip to Alton Towers takes place tomorrow with the vast majority of the school opting to take part. Hopefully this will be a lovely way to conclude our final full day of the academic year.

I am sure you will join me in wishing them the very best for the future. We are also looking forward to welcoming back Mrs Gill and Mrs Trainor in English as well as Mrs Doyle in RE as they return from maternity leave.

A reminder that Wednesday 21st July is our final day and that school finishes at 12.15pm. The school buses have been ordered and will be onsite at this time ready to take children home for the summer holiday. We return to school September on Monday 6th September for Year 7 only and all other Year groups return on Tuesday 7th September. Please ensure that you have responded to the letter sent out by Mrs Doherty regarding the testing which will take place before we return to school. On Wednesday 14th July the Department for Education published updated guidance on face coverings. In line with the latest health advice and government position they have said that children are expected to continue to wear face coverings on public transport to or from school. This includes on dedicated school transport. Please can I ask you to speak to your child to ensure they have a suitable covering with them in September.
