Dear Parent/Carer

Re: National Lockdown Week 8 Update

We are so excited to be welcoming all of our children back to St James' this week. I have spoken to numerous staff this week and every one of them has said how much they are looking forward to the wider re-opening of school, having all of the children from our school family back in the building and finally seeing our children in real life rather than on screen. A reminder that in order to facilitate the testing we are operating a staggered return:

Monday 8 th March	Year 11
Tuesday 9th March	Year 10
Wednesday 10 th March	Year 9
Thursday 11 th March	Year 8
Friday 12 th March	Year 7

The testing centre will be open from 8am each day with Form time as normal at 8.45am. We have had 90% of parents consent to their child partaking which will go some way to reducing the spread of the virus in St James'. Please do be aware, if your child tests positive you will be contacted to collect them, and they will need to isolate along with any close contacts. Please do bear this in mind as they make their way to school and again, I would advise that they do not use school/public transport where possible. In preparation for the return to school please ensure you have read my letter from 25th February and Mr Scott's letter from 3rd March. All letters are available on the website.

As you will be aware, before lockdown, we were running booster sessions in a wide range of subjects across Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4, as part of our Catch Up Strategy. These sessions are open to all and are planned lessons led by our St James' staff. Now that we are back in school, we are able to once again offer these sessions commencing week beginning 15th March. Sessions for Years 7 to 9 run from 8am until 8.25am. For Key Stage 3 these are on a rolling two-week programme to allow all Years to access the sessions. Sessions for Years 10 and 11 run from 3.10pm to 4.10pm. The sessions will have a specific focus, and this will be published weekly on Show My Homework, as well as being emailed to parents. I hope that students will gain real benefit from these sessions but are reminded that they are additional sessions and do not replace the regular routine of good study habits at home, completing homework and recapping learning. The timetable of sessions up until May half term can be found at the end of this letter.
