There are lots of other events taking place, but many of these are between 9am-3pm, so if parents are interested they may attend. These other sessions include ones on apprenticeships in specific industries that students may want to consider a career in.

T-Levels: What are they?

T-Levels are a new option for school leavers introduced for the first time in 2020. They are 2 year courses equivalent to 3 A levels. The courses are written alongside employers to make sure you get the right skills needed to get a good job after you finish.

80% of time is spent studying whilst 20% will be part of an industry placement with an employer. The difference between T-Levels and apprenticeships is that you spend more time studying and you don't get paid for doing T-Levels.

In time, students will be able to take a T Level in the following subject areas:

accounting, agriculture, land management and production, animal care and management, building services engineering for construction, catering, craft and design, design and development for engineering and manufacturing, design, surveying and planning for construction, digital business services, digital production, design and development, digital support and services, education and childcare, finance, hair, beauty and aesthetics, health, healthcare science, human resources, legal, maintenance, installation and repair for engineering and manufacturing, management and administration, engineering, manufacturing, processing and control, media, broadcast and production, onsite construction, science.
