Re: Coronavirus update 27th May

I hope you and your families are well with the current challenges you face.

On Sunday 24th June, the Prime minister talked about the wider opening of schools in his daily briefing. He said:

- Secondary schools will be asked to provide face-to-face contact for Year 10, as planned, but not until 15th June, with around a quarter of these Secondary students in at any point.

On Bank Holiday Monday (25th June) the Government published its guidance for Secondary schools on wider opening expanding on the points made by the Prime minister the previous day. We have therefore been constructing risk assessments, new timetables and ensuring the site is as safe as possible ready for the return of our staff and students.

As previously communicated in my Coronavirus update letter on 21st May I am now seeking the views of Year 10 parents and carers about whether you intend to send your child in before the summer break if the school is open. This information will inform our risk assessment and enable us to organise rooms and staffing most effectively.
