## **Suggested Packing List**

- A packed breakfast or money (Euros) for the outward journey
- A bag to carry around in the day. A rucksack would be the best idea, as you will need to carry your lunch with you
- Cameras are allowed, mobile phones are not; they will be confiscated just like in school if you do bring them!
- Pillow for the journey
- · Pencil case and notepad
- Bath towel
- Shorts
- Sweatshirts
- Trainers
- Waterproof jacket
- Nightwear
- Underwear
- German fancy dress
- Toiletries
- Watch
- Adaptor plug for electrical items
- Large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Hat and sun cream



#### Money

- All excursions and meals are included in the trip.
- Students will however need to take a packed breakfast or money (Euros) for the outward journey.

  They will need to have this in their hand luggage to take on the coach for the outward journey.
- They will also need money for the return journey to purchase an evening meal. This should be either Pounds or Euros as both can be used on the ferry.
- Any other money which students take will be for incidentals, shopping in Cochem, visit to the ice cream café, at the Theme Park etc.
- We will be collecting spending money in advance so as to ensure its safe keeping.
- We would recommend between 70 80 Euros.
- Please send cash, in Euros, in to school in sealed envelopes for each day marked with your child's name, form, Germany 2019 and the amount and hand in to the front office.
- Any money for the outward journey should be kept and children should bring that with them.
- This means there will be 4 envelopes in total each labelled as above with the days; Saturday, Sunday, Monday and Tuesday. You may wish to put some money for Tuesday in pounds as well as Euros.
- This must be handed in by Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July to ensure we have enough time to organise our banking system.

#### Medication

- Clearly labelled, in a clear plastic bag, with name of student and dosage.
- If you have not already done so via the medical form, please ensure you make one of us aware, preferably tonight and certainly in advance, if your son/daughter will be taking medication with them.
- This will need to be handed in to the medicines co-ordinators (Mrs Chadwick and Mr Maidment) on the day of departure.
- ALSO, please ensure there is enough dosage particularly for inhalers; this will help us keep your children safe.
- Any queries about medicines, please speak to one of us this evening.

- These should have been handed in on your way in tonight, if you have not yet handed them in but have them with you, please do so before you leave.
