Re: National Apprenticeship Week 2022

Dear Parent/Carer

This week is National Apprenticeship Week where across the country schools, employers and colleges are sharing information and getting people talking about apprenticeships. We wanted to share some of that information with you at home and let you know what has been going on in school to support students and raise awareness of apprenticeship opportunities.

The theme for National Apprenticeship Week 2022 is 'build the future'; reflecting on how apprenticeships can help individuals to develop the skills and knowledge required for a rewarding career, and businesses to develop a talented workforce that is equipped with future-ready skills.

In school, already this year, we have been supporting our Year 11 students in particular to access information and support around applying to apprenticeships. They have had an assembly from the ASK National Apprenticeship Programme and a number of interested students have taken part in sessions around how they can send off their applications. Year 11 are also being regularly updated by Miss Ashworth about the current apprenticeship vacancies available to them.

This week in school form tutors will be having conversations with students about apprenticeships and will be demystifying some of the myths and misconceptions about them as well. We have informative videos about apprenticeships to show to KS3 as well as real-life apprentice stories that we will be sharing with KS4.
