I cannot believe that we have only been back for just over a week, so much has happened and taken place during this time. Our live Zoom lessons have continued following our normal school day and pupils have benefited from some time with their form at the start of each day. Our lateral flow testing facility is ready to test those students and staff who are currently in school. The first tests of children will take place on Tuesday and Friday of this week. When we return to school, more information will be sent out so that all students can access this testing provision if you consent as a parent/carer.

The biggest questions in education at the moment are surrounding the Year 11 examinations and what the grading will look like. Currently there are no answers, only questions and suggestions. Dr Guscott has provided an update on the curriculum for all year groups but a particular focus of his half termly update is around what we know so far about the Year 11 exams.
