test will only last 45 minutes. CATs are designed not to test knowledge or fact retention but children's abilities to think in particular ways including understanding, memory, reasoning and decision-making. These tests allow us to see what each child's academic potential might be, as well as to

identify weaker areas that may need additional support.

17th September Year 7 Parent Tutor Evening; this will be held remotely with more

information to follow

7th October Year 7 Welcome Mass (pending Diocesan approval); this will be held during

the school day but due to Covid restrictions we will be unable to invite parents on to site. We will however be live streaming the Mass so that you can join in the celebration with your son or daughter. More information to
