## **CURRICULUM MAP YEAR 8 GERMAN**

The present and past tense



Due to school closure, pupils have missed face to face teaching of word order (verb 2<sup>nd</sup> after adverbs of frequency), the use of weil (verb to the end), using gern/nicht gern to express opinions, use of 3<sup>rd</sup> person. Each week, there must be a focus on present and past tense with special attention being paid to those grammar points previously mentioned. Also, an interleaving starter of grammar or vocabulary for each lesson. One lesson per week the interleaving should focus on what was covered in year 7 or earlier in year 8 (including sports and hobbies) and the other lesson should focus on something from the current half term. This is in addition to amendments highlighted below.
