Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Arrangements for Year 9 Options Evening (Thursday 10th February, 4.00-7.00 pm)

As explained in the letter to Year 9 parents sent out on 17th December, there will be an Options Evening for Year 9 parents and pupils on <u>Thursday 10th February, 4-7pm</u>. This will be an opportunity to find out more about the Key Stage 4 curriculum that your child will be studying from September 2022, and to discuss the subject options available with teaching staff. Our Careers Adviser, Miss Grace Ashworth, will also be available on the evening to discuss subject choices and post-16 opportunities.

You should have already received a copy of the 2022 Curriculum Brochure which contains all of the relevant information, and this is also available at <u>www.stjamescheadle.co.uk/</u> If having read the Curriculum brochure you would still like to discuss your child's options with staff, you will need to make appointments virtually with staff on our SchoolCloud booking system at <u>https://stjamescheadle.schoolcloud.co.uk</u>. This will enable you to make appointments with subjects that you would like more information on, as well as Dr. Guscott (Options lead), Miss Cheshire (Head of Year 9), Mrs. Bickerton (SENCO) and Miss Ashworth (Careers Adviser) if you wish. **You are not expected to make appointments for all of the option subjects or core subjects**. Staff will have a limited number of appointments available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Some subjects will have a high demand from parents and students and their appointment times will get booked up quickly. If you are unable to speak to a member of staff on the evening, please feel free to contact them at school in the usual way.

- Please be patient at the start of each appointment, as the teacher can begin the meeting at any point within the first 30 seconds. <u>Appointments will last for a maximum of 4 minutes</u>
