Pope Francis was at heart a compassionate and humble pastor who showed a deep empathy for all humanity, especially those who are too often forgotten. He was a teacher who listened and found the words to connect, and Catholic Social Teaching grew under his Pontificate. His stature as a world leader will be remembered on so many issues especially his concern for peace and stewardship of the world's resources for the benefit of everyone.
