We cannot wait to welcome them in September.

You may note our new letterhead which includes our new School Games GOLD Mark Award for the 2022/23 academic year. The School Games Mark is a Government-led award scheme which is facilitated by the Youth Sports Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community. We are delighted to have been recognised for our success. Our sport achievements this year include; Greater Manchester School's Boy Badminton Champions at KS3 and 4, Greater Manchester Catholic School's Football Champions at Year 8, Stockport School's Football Cup Winners at Year 10, Stockport School's Football League Cup Champions at Year 8 and Stockport School's Athletics Quad Champions at Year 7. With a total of 348 children competing in local inter-school competitions this year, we are extremely proud of our children and staff for their hard work and dedication.
