Re: Summer Term Week 8 Headteacher Update

Our Year 11 children are now back into the routine and rhythm of their examinations following the half term break. Please continue to keep all our Year 11 children in your thoughts and prayers as their examinations continue. Although the examination period is relentless, we have the opportunity to celebrate at the Leavers' Mass which is taking place at Christ Church on 28th June at 6pm, Prom which takes place at Edgeley Park on 29th June at 6pm and Prize Evening in November in school.

Advanced notice that on Thursday 22nd June our Excellence Evening takes place. All children from each Year group are invited to attend their presentations at the times below where the Head of Year will present a limited number of awards for each subject area, our three core values of Family, Faith, Excellence and finally the Spirit of St James' award. The presentations will begin at the following times in the Main Hall: **Year 7** - **5:00pm, Year 8 - 5:30pm, Year 9 - 6:00pm and Year 10 - 6:30pm**.
