This week's Celebration of the Word is taken from Mark 6:1-6, where Jesus returns to His hometown and faces rejection from those who knew Him. This Gospel challenges our children to remain steadfast in their own faith journeys, even when faced with difficulties or misunderstanding.

Our Form Saint of the Week is St James the Lesser, one of the apostles and a leader in the early Church. St James reminds us that faithfulness and humility are essential in serving others. He said, "Be doers of the word, and not hearers only" (James 1:22), encouraging us to live out our faith through actions, not just words.
