Some of the personal data held is obtained directly from the parents and pupils, and some information is received from the local authority and other third party organisations.

Where necessary information may be shared with other organisations to assist us in providing education to pupils. Personal data will only be kept for as long as the law specifies, or where unspecified personal data will be kept for the length of time determined by our business requirements.
