


## Questionnaire for Parents and Carers Year 10 | 2020/21

The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved






The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year

The school environment clearly shows the Catholic Life of the school






## My child enjoys and actively participates in Collective Worship

The school has high expectations for my child






My child does well at this school

The school lets me know how my child is doing






There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school

The school supports my child's wider personal development






My child has been bullied and the school dealt with this quickly and effectively


I had concerns and the school has dealt with them properly
